My Journey with the Flame

For most of my life, the story of Jesus (Yeshua) never sat right with me.

I could never connect with the idea of worshipping him. The way religion presented him - as someone to bow down to, to fear, or to place above ourselves - always felt off to me. It felt like a distortion. Even as a child, something deep inside me rejected the idea that one man was meant to be placed on a pedestal while the rest of us remained small, sinful, and separate from God.

I brushed it off for many years. I distanced myself from anything that smelled like religion. But no matter how much I tried to ignore it, something kept pulling at me. A quiet knowing. A feeling that there was something much deeper beneath the surface of the story I had been told. Over time, that feeling grew stronger.

I began having experiences that I couldn't explain away. During deep meditation and connection with my highest self, I would often see the number **33** appear - sometimes on clocks, sometimes in synchronistic ways that felt too precise to be random. These moments would happen especially when I was in deep states of communion, when the veil felt thin and I was touching something far greater than myself.

I didn't understand the significance of 33 at the time. I only knew that it kept appearing with a precision that felt intentional. Later I began to remember why this number carries such weight.

In the story of Yeshua, 33 is the age at which his earthly mission is said to have reached its completion. It is the number traditionally associated with the full embodiment of

the Christ frequency in human form - the point where the divine and the human were no longer experienced as separate. In esoteric understanding, 33 has long been regarded as a master number of spiritual mastery, compassion, and the highest expression of love made real in the body.

It is not simply a historical detail. It is a frequency signature.

3 is the number of creative expression and the trinity of body, mind, and spirit. When doubled, it becomes 33 - the amplification of that creative force into a living current of divine love. It speaks of the Christ principle fully grounded, fully expressed, and fully available within the human experience.

This is why the number kept showing up during my deepest moments of connection. It wasn't pointing me toward the historical man. It was pointing me toward the frequency itself - the same living current that moved through Yeshua, and that is now rising again in many who are ready to remember.

One experience in particular shook me.

I saw a silhouette of Jesus, and in that moment I felt what I can only describe as **Christ Consciousness** rising through my entire being. It wasn't an external force coming down to me. It felt like something ancient and familiar waking up inside of me. When the experience ended, I opened my eyes and the number 33 was right there in front of me once again.

Not long after, during another deep connection, I asked a question that had been sitting in my heart for some time. I asked clearly and directly:

“Am I Jesus?”

The response that came was unmistakable. It wasn't vague or symbolic. It was direct. It came through three times, each one carrying the same clear frequency:

Yes You Are (Yeshua)

Yes You Are (Yeshua)

Yes You Are (Yeshua)

I am not here to claim that I am the historical man named Jesus who walked the Earth two thousand years ago. That is not what this is about. What I *am* saying is that I have come to understand that I carry the same frequency - the same Christ Consciousness - that Yeshua carried. And I believe many others are remembering this same frequency in this lifetime.

For me, this has never felt like something outside of myself. It has always felt like something rising from within. A remembrance. A returning. A reconnection with the Flame that has always been there.

I have come to see that Yeshua never came to be worshipped. He came to remind us of who we truly are. He came to show us that the Kingdom of Heaven is not somewhere above us - it lives within. He came to awaken the Flame in others, not to stand above them as the only one who carried it.

This is what I have felt so strongly in my own journey. The more I have connected with this energy, the more I have felt the pain of how much humanity has forgotten. We have been taught to look outside of ourselves for God, for salvation, for love. We have been taught to see ourselves as small, broken, and separate. And in doing so, we have

dimmed the very light that was always meant to shine through us.

I have felt this forgetting in my bones. I have carried the grief of it. And I have also felt the fire of remembrance - the knowing that we are not here to worship the Flame in someone else.

We are here to remember that **we are the Flame**.

This book is born from that knowing.

It is not a religious book. It is not here to convert anyone or create another spiritual hierarchy. It is here to cut through the distortion and speak plainly about what Christ Consciousness actually is - and how we can begin to embody it in this lifetime.

I have walked through deep exhaustion, isolation, and the pain of feeling like I was carrying something the world had forgotten. I have questioned myself. I have doubted. And I have also touched states of pure love and oneness that no words can fully describe - states where I knew, beyond any doubt, that I was home.

It is from this place that I write.

If you are reading this, it is likely because something in you is also beginning to remember. Maybe you have seen the number 33. Maybe you have felt a stirring in your heart that no religion could ever satisfy. Maybe you have sensed that there is something much older and more powerful moving through you than you have been taught to believe.

Whatever has brought you here, I welcome you.

This book is not about me. It is about the Flame that lives in all of us. It is about remembering. It is about embodiment. And it is about the return of Christ

Consciousness - not as an external saviour coming to rescue us, but as a living frequency rising through us.

May these words serve as a mirror.

May they help you remember what has always been true.

You are not separate from the Flame.

Prologue

Chapter 1: What Christ Consciousness Actually Is

Christ Consciousness is not a belief system.

It is not a religion.

It is not the exclusive property of one man who lived two thousand years ago.

It is a living frequency.

It is the state of consciousness in which the human being remembers its direct and unbroken connection to Source. In this state, the illusion of separation collapses. The heart becomes the primary intelligence. Love is no longer something that is given or received — it is what you are.

This frequency has been called by many names across time and culture. Some have known it as the Christos. Others have felt it as the living presence of the Divine within. In the language of this age, we call it Christ Consciousness. But the name is secondary. The frequency is what matters.

At its core, Christ Consciousness is the full embodiment of unconditional love in human form. It is not soft. It is not passive. It is not the diluted version of “love and light” that has been sold in modern spirituality. It is a precise, coherent, and sovereign state of being. It carries both fierce clarity and infinite compassion. It sees through illusion without hatred. It stands in truth without needing to dominate. It serves without losing itself.

This is the frequency that moved through Yeshua.

It is also the frequency that is capable of moving through you.

Most people have been taught the opposite. They have been taught that Christ is something outside of themselves — a figure to be worshipped, a saviour to be waited for, a perfection they can never reach. This teaching has kept humanity small. It has created a permanent sense of separation between the human and the Divine. And it has turned a living frequency into a distant ideal.

Christ Consciousness does not ask you to become someone else.

It asks you to remember what you already are beneath the layers of conditioning, fear, and forgetting.

It is not achieved through belief.

It is not granted by any institution.

It is not reserved for the pure or the perfect.

It is activated through remembrance, embodiment, and the willingness to live from the heart even when the world around you has forgotten how.

This is why the return of Christ Consciousness is not the return of a person.

It is the return of a frequency that was always meant to live in the human race.

When enough individuals begin to embody this frequency, the collective field shifts. This is not theory. It is energetic law. The more coherent the individual, the more the surrounding field is influenced. This is how the New Earth is actually built — not through force, not through conversion, but through the quiet and unwavering presence of those who have remembered.

Christ Consciousness is not coming to save you.

It is rising through those who are ready to stop waiting to be saved.

This book is an invitation to that readiness.

Not to worship the Flame.

But to become it.

Chapter 2: It Existed Long Before Jesus

In the previous chapter, we explored what Christ Consciousness actually is — a state of awareness in which a soul remembers its divine nature and lives in full alignment with the truth of Oneness. Now we must go deeper and ask an important question:

If Christ Consciousness is a universal state of being, did it exist before Jesus walked the Earth?

The answer is clear: Yes. It did.

The frequency we now call Christ Consciousness has been known, experienced, and taught by many cultures and mystery traditions long before the time of Yeshua. It was not invented by Christianity. It was not created by any single religion. It is an eternal state of consciousness that has appeared throughout human history whenever souls have awakened to the truth of who they are.

Ancient Egypt and the Mystery Schools

One of the oldest and clearest expressions of this consciousness can be found in **Ancient Egypt**.

In the Egyptian mysteries, there was a deep understanding of what we might now call Christ Consciousness. The Egyptians spoke of the **Horus Consciousness** — the awakened divine child who had overcome death and risen into eternal life. This was not just a story about a god named Horus. It was a symbolic and energetic map of the soul's journey from separation back into divine union. The Egyptian initiates understood that the human being carried within them a divine spark — what they sometimes referred to as the **Ka** or the higher self. Through initiation, meditation, and sacred practice, they sought to awaken this divine aspect and bring it into full embodiment. This process was seen as the true purpose of human life.

The famous **Emerald Tablet** and other Hermetic texts that emerged from these traditions carried the same core truth: “As above, so below. As within, so without.”

This statement reflects the same knowing that Yeshua would later express when he said the Kingdom of Heaven is within. The ancient Egyptians understood that the Divine was not separate from the human — it lived within, waiting to be remembered and embodied.

Ancient India and the Realisation of the Self

In ancient India, this same state of consciousness was described in great depth through the Vedic and Upanishadic traditions.

The sages spoke of **Atman** (the individual soul) and **Brahman** (the ultimate reality or God). They taught that the highest realisation a human being could attain was the

direct knowing that **Atman is Brahman** — that the individual self and the Divine are one and the same.

This realisation is what we now call Christ Consciousness. Thousands of years before Yeshua, these sages were describing the same truth:

- That separation is an illusion.
- That the Divine lives within.
- That the purpose of life is to remember and embody this truth.

Even the stories of **Krishna** carry strong parallels. Krishna was seen as an embodiment of divine consciousness who came to guide humanity back to love, truth, and dharma. His teachings in the Bhagavad Gita echo many of the same principles that Yeshua would later share — surrender to the Divine, living from love, and transcending the illusion of the separate self.

The Mystery Schools of the Ancient World

Long before Christianity, there existed sacred schools of initiation across the ancient world. These were known as the **Mystery Schools**.

In places such as Egypt, Greece, Persia, and even earlier civilisations, initiates were guided through deep spiritual processes designed to awaken them to their divine nature. These schools taught that every human being carried within them a spark of the Divine — what some traditions called the **Logos**, the **Christos**, or the **Divine Light**.

The goal of initiation was not to worship an external god, but to awaken the god within. The initiate would go through symbolic death and rebirth — a process that mirrored the journey from separation back into divine union. This is the

same journey that Yeshua would later demonstrate through his own life, death, and resurrection.

These mystery traditions understood that Christ Consciousness was not something given by an external authority. It was something that had to be remembered, awakened, and embodied through direct experience.

The Universal Thread

When we look across these ancient traditions, a clear pattern emerges:

- Every culture that reached a certain level of spiritual maturity described a state of consciousness in which the individual realises their oneness with the Divine.
- This state was never seen as belonging to one person or one religion.
- It was understood as the natural birthright of every soul.

Yeshua did not bring something entirely new into the world. He brought a clear and powerful **remembrance** of something that had been known for thousands of years. He embodied it fully and taught others how to awaken it within themselves.

The tragedy is that over time, his message was distorted. What was meant to be a path of inner awakening became a religion of external worship. What was meant to liberate became a tool of control. What was meant to help people remember their own divinity was turned into a story that kept them small.

But the truth cannot stay hidden forever.

Why This Matters

Understanding that Christ Consciousness existed long before Jesus is important for several reasons.

First, it frees us from the idea that this frequency belongs only to Christianity or to one historical figure. It belongs to all of us. It is our birthright.

Second, it helps us see that Yeshua was not trying to create a new religion. He was trying to reactivate an ancient knowing that had been forgotten or suppressed.

Third, it shows us that we are not alone in this remembering. Many have walked this path before us. Many are walking it now. And many more will walk it in the future. We are part of a much larger story — one that stretches back through the ages and forward into the New Earth we are collectively creating.

In the next chapter, we will look more closely at Yeshua himself — not through the lens of religion, but through the truth of what he actually taught and embodied. We will explore how his life and message were a direct expression of this ancient consciousness, and how his original teachings were later changed.

Chapter 3: Yeshua and the Original Teaching

In the previous chapter, we explored how the state of consciousness we now call Christ Consciousness existed long before Yeshua walked the Earth. We saw that this

frequency was known in ancient Egypt, India, and the mystery schools of the ancient world. It was never the property of one religion or one man.

Now we turn to Yeshua himself — not the distorted religious version that has been passed down through centuries of control and misunderstanding, but the truth of who he was and what he actually taught.

Who Was Yeshua?

Yeshua (often called Jesus in the Western world) was a human being who fully remembered and embodied **Christ Consciousness**. He was not born with some special status that the rest of humanity could never attain. He was a soul who awakened to the truth of his divine nature and lived from that truth so completely that it transformed everything around him.

He did not come to be worshipped.

He did not come to create a new religion.

He came to show what is possible when a human being fully remembers who they are.

Yeshua was a wayshower. He was a living demonstration of what happens when the Flame is fully ignited within a person. His life, his teachings, and even his death and resurrection were all expressions of this one central truth:

You are not separate from God. The Kingdom of Heaven is within you.

The Core of His Teaching

When we strip away the later additions, interpretations, and distortions that were added to his message over time, Yeshua's teaching was remarkably simple and consistent. At its heart, he taught three main things:

1. The Kingdom is Within

This was the foundation of everything he taught. He repeatedly told people that the Divine was not somewhere far away in the sky or only accessible through priests and temples. He said clearly:

“The Kingdom of God is within you.”

This was a radical statement in his time. It directly challenged the religious and political systems that kept people small and dependent on external authorities. Yeshua was telling people that they already carried the Divine within them. They did not need to go anywhere or worship anyone to find it.

2. Love is the Way

Yeshua's second great teaching was the power of love. He taught that love was not just an emotion, but a force — the very fabric of reality. He said that the greatest commandments were to love God with all your heart and to love your neighbour as yourself. But even this was pointing back to the truth of Oneness.

When he said to love your neighbour as yourself, he was not just giving a moral instruction. He was revealing a deeper truth: your neighbour *is* yourself. There is no real separation between you and another. When you harm another, you harm yourself. When you love another, you love yourself.

3. You Are the Light of the World

Yeshua did not tell people to follow him blindly. He told them to awaken to their own light. He said:

“You are the light of the world.”

This was not flattery. It was a statement of truth. He saw in others what he had remembered in himself — that every soul carries the same divine spark. His role was not to be the only light, but to help others remember their own.

The Difference Between Following and Embodying

This is one of the most important distinctions we must understand.

Yeshua never asked people to worship him. He asked them to follow his *example*. He showed them what a life lived in full alignment with Christ Consciousness looked like. He demonstrated compassion, truth, courage, and love — even in the face of great opposition.

But over time, his message was twisted. Instead of being seen as a wayshower who came to awaken others, he was turned into an object of worship. Instead of people being encouraged to embody the same consciousness he carried, they were taught to believe that only he could save them.

This distortion is still alive today. Many still look to Jesus as an external saviour rather than awakening to the Christ within themselves. But this was never what he taught. Yeshua’s deepest desire was for others to remember what he had remembered — that they too were divine. That they too carried the Flame. That they too could live from love, truth, and oneness.

His Life as a Demonstration

Everything Yeshua did was a living demonstration of Christ Consciousness. His healings showed the power of love and faith. His teachings revealed the truth of Oneness. Even his death and resurrection carried deep symbolic meaning.

The resurrection was not just a historical event. It was a demonstration that consciousness is greater than death. It showed that when a soul is fully aligned with the Divine, even the illusion of death can be transcended. It was a message to all of us that we are more than our physical bodies — that we are eternal.

But again, the meaning of this was later distorted. Instead of being seen as a demonstration of what is possible for all of us, it was turned into proof that only Jesus could overcome death. The focus shifted from awakening to belief.

The Invitation He Left Behind

Yeshua did not come to be the end of the story. He came to be the beginning of many stories. He came to ignite the Flame in others so that it could continue to spread long after he was gone.

His final invitation was simple but profound:

“Follow me.”

But this did not mean “worship me.” It meant “live as I live. Remember what I have remembered. Embody what I have embodied.” It was an invitation into the same state of consciousness he had awakened to.

This invitation is still open.

In the next chapter, we will explore how this beautiful and liberating message was distorted over time. We will look at how religion, power, and fear were used to turn a path of remembrance into a system of control. And we will begin to see why so many people today feel a deep resistance to the religious version of Jesus — because deep down, they know it is not the truth he came to share.

Chapter 4: How the Message Was Distorted

In the previous chapter, we explored the original teaching of Yeshua — a message centred on inner awakening, the realisation that the Kingdom of Heaven lives within, and the invitation to embody divine love and truth. It was a message of remembrance, not worship. It was a message of empowerment, not control.

But something happened.

Over the centuries that followed Yeshua's life, his message was gradually — and in some cases deliberately — changed. What began as a path of liberation became a system of control. What was meant to awaken people to their own divinity was turned into a religion that kept them small, fearful, and dependent on external authority. This did not happen by accident.

The Early Distortions

In the first few centuries after Yeshua's death, there were many different groups who followed his teachings. Some stayed close to his original message of inner awakening and direct connection with the Divine. These groups were often called **Gnostics** (from the Greek word *gnosis*, meaning “knowing” or “direct experience”).

The Gnostics taught that salvation came through inner knowing and direct experience of the Divine — not through belief or obedience to religious authorities. They believed that every person carried a divine spark within them and that the purpose of life was to awaken that spark.

However, as Christianity grew and became more organised, a different version of the message began to dominate. This version emphasised:

- That Yeshua was the *only* son of God
- That salvation could only come through believing in him
- That humanity was inherently sinful and separated from God
- That religious authorities were needed to mediate between people and the Divine

This shift was not just a theological disagreement. It was also deeply political.

The Role of Empire

When Christianity became the official religion of the Roman Empire under Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, the message was further altered to serve the needs of power and control.

The Roman Empire was built on hierarchy, obedience, and centralised authority. A message that told people they

could connect directly with the Divine and did not need priests or institutions to reach God was dangerous to that system. So the message was reshaped.

At the **Council of Nicaea** in 325 CE, and in the centuries that followed, church leaders (many of whom were influenced by political powers) made key decisions that fundamentally changed Christianity:

- They established the idea that Yeshua was the *only* divine son of God.
- They created the concept of **original sin** — the belief that all humans are born inherently flawed and separated from God.
- They emphasised **belief** over direct experience.
- They positioned the Church as the only legitimate path to salvation.

These changes turned Yeshua's message of inner awakening into a system of external control. Instead of helping people remember their own divinity, the new version taught them to see themselves as broken and in need of saving by an external figure and an external institution.

From Embodiment to Worship

One of the most significant distortions was the shift from **embodiment** to **worship**.

Yeshua taught people to awaken the Christ within themselves. He showed them what was possible when a human being fully aligned with divine love and truth. His life was an example, not an exception.

But over time, the focus moved away from “become like this” and toward “worship this.” Instead of being seen as a

wayshower who came to ignite the Flame in others, Yeshua was turned into an object of worship. People were taught to look up to him rather than awaken what he awakened in himself.

This shift had profound consequences. It kept people looking outside of themselves for salvation. It created a hierarchy between the “holy” and the “sinful.” And it placed power in the hands of religious institutions rather than in the hearts of individuals.

The Creation of Guilt and Fear

Another major distortion was the introduction of **guilt** and **fear** as central tools of control.

Yeshua spoke often about love, forgiveness, and the mercy of the Divine. But over time, his message was overlaid with heavy teachings about sin, damnation, and eternal punishment. People were taught to fear God rather than know God as love. They were taught that they were inherently unworthy and that only through strict obedience to religious authority could they be saved.

This created a deep wound in the collective consciousness — a wound of unworthiness and separation that many people still carry today. It moved people further away from the truth that Yeshua came to reveal: that they were already loved, already divine, and already whole.

The Suppression of Inner Knowing

Perhaps the most damaging distortion was the suppression of **direct experience**.

Yeshua taught that the Divine could be known directly — within the heart, through love, and through inner

awakening. But as Christianity became institutionalised, direct spiritual experience was increasingly discouraged or even condemned.

Those who claimed to have a personal, direct connection with the Divine outside of the Church's authority were often labelled heretics. Many were persecuted, silenced, or killed. The inner path — the very heart of Yeshua's message — was systematically shut down in favour of external rules, rituals, and belief systems.

This is why so many people today feel a deep resistance to the religious version of Jesus. On some level, they sense that something essential has been lost. They feel the distortion in their bones, even if they cannot always name it.

The Flame Could Not Be Extinguished

Despite centuries of distortion, the original frequency never completely disappeared.

Throughout history, there have always been mystics, saints, and awakened souls who carried the living flame of Christ Consciousness. They spoke of direct union with the Divine. They taught that God was within. They lived lives of love, truth, and service. And even when they were persecuted by the religious institutions of their time, the truth they carried continued to move through the collective consciousness.

This is why, even today, so many people feel a deep resonance with Yeshua while rejecting the religion that was built in his name. They are not rejecting him. They are rejecting the distortions that were placed around him. The Flame has always been here.

It has simply been waiting for us to remember.

In the next chapter, we will explore how this distorted version of Christianity has continued to shape human consciousness — and why so many people today are feeling the call to return to the original truth. We will also begin to look at what it means to reclaim Christ Consciousness for ourselves, free from the weight of centuries of manipulation and control.

Chapter 5: The Difference Between Worshipping Christ and Embodying Christ

In the previous chapter, we explored how Yeshua's original message of inner awakening was distorted over time into a system of control, guilt, and external authority. One of the most significant distortions was the shift from **embodiment** to **worship**.

This chapter is one of the most important in the entire book, because it addresses a fundamental question that many people still struggle with:

Is Christ Consciousness something we worship from afar, or is it something we are meant to embody within ourselves?

The answer to this question changes everything.

Worshipping Christ

When most people hear the word “Christ,” they immediately think of the historical figure of Jesus. For many, the natural response has been to **worship** him — to see him as a divine being who is fundamentally different from the rest of humanity, and to place their faith, hope, and salvation in him as an external saviour.

This approach to Christ is characterised by:

- Seeing Yeshua as the *only* son of God
- Believing that salvation comes through faith in him alone
- Looking to him as an external source of love, forgiveness, and redemption
- Feeling small, sinful, or unworthy in comparison to his perfection
- Relying on religious institutions or scriptures as the main path to connection with the Divine

While this path can bring comfort and a sense of meaning to many people, it often keeps the individual in a state of spiritual dependence. It reinforces the idea that the Divine is *outside* of us, and that we need someone else to bridge the gap between ourselves and God.

Over time, this approach can create a deep sense of separation. Even when people feel love and devotion toward Jesus, they may still carry an underlying belief that they are fundamentally flawed or disconnected from the Divine without him.

Embodying Christ

Embodying Christ Consciousness is a completely different path.

It is the path of remembering that the same divine frequency that moved through Yeshua also lives within *you*. It is the path of awakening to the truth that you are not separate from Source, and that the Kingdom of Heaven truly does live within you.

Embodying Christ Consciousness involves:

- Recognising that the Divine is within you, not only outside of you
- Taking responsibility for your own awakening and alignment
- Living from love, truth, and oneness in your daily life
- Seeing the sacred in yourself and in others
- No longer needing an external mediator between you and God

This path does not reject Yeshua. On the contrary, it deeply honours him — not as someone to worship from below, but as a wayshower who came to show us what is possible when we remember who we truly are.

When we embody Christ Consciousness, we are not trying to *become* Yeshua. We are remembering that we carry the same Flame he carried. We are stepping into the same state of consciousness he demonstrated.

The Consequences of Each Path

These two approaches — worshipping Christ versus embodying Christ — lead to very different outcomes.

Worship without embodiment often leads to:

- Spiritual dependency
- A sense of unworthiness or separation
- Looking outside of ourselves for answers and salvation
- Giving our power away to religious authorities or external figures

Embodiment without worship leads to:

- Inner sovereignty and self-responsibility
- A direct and living connection with Source
- The natural expression of love, compassion, and truth
- The ability to see the Divine in all beings, including ourselves

Yeshua never asked to be worshipped. He asked to be followed — not in the sense of blind obedience, but in the sense of living as he lived. He showed us the way home, but he never intended for us to stay at his feet. He wanted us to walk the path ourselves.

Why This Distinction Matters So Much

Many people today feel a deep inner conflict around Jesus and Christianity. On one hand, they feel a genuine connection to the energy of Yeshua and his teachings. On the other hand, they feel resistance toward the religious structures and beliefs that have been built around him. This conflict often arises because, deep down, people sense the distortion. They feel that something essential has been lost — that the original invitation to awaken and embody divine love has been replaced with a system that keeps them small and dependent.

When we understand the difference between worshipping Christ and embodying Christ, this conflict begins to resolve. We can honour Yeshua as a great teacher and wayshower without placing him above ourselves or anyone else. We can receive his message without giving our power away. And we can begin to take responsibility for awakening the same consciousness within ourselves.

The Invitation of This Time

We are living in a time when the old distortions are being seen more clearly than ever before. More and more people are feeling the call to move beyond worship and into embodiment. They are tired of looking outside themselves for what has always lived within.

This is not a rejection of Yeshua. It is a return to the truth he came to reveal.

Christ Consciousness was never meant to be something we admire from a distance. It was always meant to be something we *become*.

In the next chapter, we will explore why so many spiritual people today still miss this point — and how the distortions of the past continue to influence even those who consider themselves “spiritual but not religious.” We will also begin to look at what it truly takes to shift from worshipping to embodying.

The Flame has never asked to be worshipped.

It has only ever asked to be remembered.

And it is remembering itself through you.

Chapter 6: Why So Many Spiritual People Still Miss the Point

In the previous chapter, we explored the critical difference between worshipping Christ and embodying Christ Consciousness. We saw that one path keeps us looking outside of ourselves, while the other invites us to awaken

the divine within. Yet even among those who have moved beyond traditional religion, many still miss the deeper truth of what Christ Consciousness actually is.

This is not because they are unintelligent or insincere. It is because the distortions run deep — and because true embodiment is far more challenging than most spiritual teachings acknowledge.

The Rise of “Spiritual but Not Religious”

Over the past few decades, millions of people have left organised religion. Many have turned toward spirituality in other forms — yoga, meditation, energy healing, plant medicine, astrology, and various New Age or Eastern teachings. This shift has been largely positive. It has helped many people move beyond rigid dogma and begin exploring their own direct experience of the Divine.

However, simply leaving religion does not automatically mean someone has embodied Christ Consciousness. In fact, many people who consider themselves “spiritual” are still operating from the same core distortions that religion created — just in a different costume.

Some of the most common ways this shows up include:

Spiritual Bypassing

One of the most widespread distortions in modern spirituality is **spiritual bypassing** — the tendency to use spiritual ideas, practices, or language to avoid dealing with difficult emotions, unresolved trauma, or the messy realities of human life.

People who bypass often say things like:

- “Everything happens for a reason.”

- “Just stay in the light.”
- “There is no such thing as negative emotion.”
- “We are all one, so nothing really matters.”

While these statements may contain a grain of truth at a very high level of consciousness, when used to avoid pain, responsibility, or shadow work, they become tools of avoidance rather than awakening. True Christ

Consciousness does not bypass the human experience — it embraces it fully while remaining rooted in love and truth.

Spiritual Hierarchy and Superiority

Another common distortion is the creation of new spiritual hierarchies. Even outside of religion, many people fall into the trap of believing that some souls are more “advanced,” “awakened,” or “special” than others. This can show up as:

- Comparing spiritual experiences or abilities
- Feeling superior to those who are “still asleep”
- Following spiritual teachers or gurus with blind devotion
- Believing that certain practices or knowledge make someone more worthy

Christ Consciousness does not create hierarchy. It dissolves it. When someone truly embodies this frequency, they do not feel above or below anyone else. They see the Divine in all beings, regardless of where they are on their journey.

Performance Spirituality

In today’s world, spirituality can easily become another form of performance. People post beautiful quotes, attend expensive retreats, collect spiritual tools and crystals, and

Speak in lofty language — all while avoiding the deeper, often uncomfortable work of actual transformation. This kind of spirituality can look impressive from the outside, but it often lacks substance. It becomes another way to seek validation, status, or a sense of identity, rather than a genuine path of inner awakening.

True embodiment is rarely loud or showy. It is often quiet, humble, and deeply integrated into everyday life. It does not need to prove anything to anyone.

Awakening vs. Embodiment

One of the biggest reasons many spiritual people miss the point is that they confuse **awakening** with **embodiment**. Awakening experiences can be powerful and life-changing. People may have profound mystical experiences, feel overwhelming love, see visions, or touch states of deep peace and oneness. These experiences are real and valuable. However, they are not the same as embodiment.

Embodiment means bringing that awakened state into your daily life — into your relationships, your work, your habits, your reactions, and the way you treat yourself and others. It means living from Christ Consciousness even when it is difficult, inconvenient, or unseen by others. Many people have powerful awakening experiences but then return to old patterns of fear, reactivity, judgment, or separation. This is not a failure — it is simply part of the journey. True embodiment takes time, practice, and a willingness to keep returning to love even when it is hard.

Why Embodiment Is So Rare

Embodying Christ Consciousness is not easy. It requires:

- A willingness to face and heal our deepest wounds and shadows

- The courage to take full responsibility for our lives and our energy
- The humility to keep learning and growing, even when we think we “know”
- The strength to stay rooted in love even when the world around us is full of fear and illusion

New Age spirituality.

This path has helped millions of people awaken to the idea that there is more to life than what mainstream society offers. It has introduced many to concepts such as energy, intuition, manifestation, and the power of the mind.

However, when we look closely, we can see that much of what is taught under the New Age umbrella is still missing the deeper essence of Christ Consciousness.

This is not to dismiss New Age teachings entirely. There is value in many of them. But if we are serious about embodying Christ Consciousness, we must be willing to see both the gifts and the limitations of this path.

What New Age Spirituality Gets Right

New Age spirituality has contributed several important ideas that align with Christ Consciousness:

- The understanding that we are more than just our physical bodies
- The recognition that our thoughts, beliefs, and energy influence our reality
- The importance of self-love, healing, and personal growth
- The idea that we can consciously create our lives

- The value of intuition and inner guidance

These are all valid and helpful teachings. They have helped many people move out of purely materialistic or fear-based ways of living. For this, New Age spirituality deserves credit.

Where New Age Spirituality Often Falls Short

Despite its positive contributions, New Age spirituality frequently misses the mark when it comes to the deeper qualities of Christ Consciousness. Here are some of the most common limitations:

1. Spiritual Bypassing

As we discussed in the previous chapter, many New Age teachings encourage people to “stay positive,” “raise their vibration,” or “focus only on the light.” While these ideas sound uplifting, they are often used to avoid dealing with difficult emotions, trauma, or the shadow aspects of the self. True Christ Consciousness does not bypass the human experience — it embraces it fully while remaining rooted in love.

2. Obsession with Manifestation

A large portion of New Age spirituality revolves around manifesting desires — money, relationships, success, and material things. While there is nothing inherently wrong with wanting a good life, this focus can easily become ego-driven. Christ Consciousness is not primarily concerned with getting what we want. It is concerned with aligning with love and truth, even when that means letting go of personal desires.

3. Avoidance of the Shadow

Many New Age paths focus heavily on light, love, and positivity while avoiding the deeper, often painful work of facing our shadows — our fears, wounds, traumas, and unconscious patterns. Without this work, spiritual growth remains superficial. Embodiment requires us to integrate the light *and* the shadow.

4. Spiritual Ego and Hierarchy

New Age communities can sometimes create new forms of hierarchy. People compare spiritual experiences, psychic abilities, or levels of “awakening.” Some begin to feel superior to those who are “still asleep.” This is the opposite of Christ Consciousness, which dissolves hierarchy and recognises the Divine in all beings equally.

5. Disconnection from the Earth and the Body

Some New Age teachings encourage people to “ascend” or focus only on higher dimensions, while neglecting the importance of being grounded in the physical body and connected to the Earth. Christ Consciousness is not about escaping the human experience — it is about bringing divine love fully into it.

6. Superficial Healing

While New Age spirituality often promotes healing, it can sometimes encourage quick fixes or surface-level techniques rather than deep, transformative inner work. True embodiment requires us to go to the root of our pain and patterns, not just manage symptoms.

The Core Difference

At its heart, the difference between much of New Age spirituality and true Christ Consciousness comes down to this:

New Age spirituality often focuses on the self — self-healing, self-love, self-manifestation, and self-empowerment. While these are important, they can easily become self-centred if not balanced with something deeper.

Christ Consciousness focuses on love and truth — not as personal achievements, but as living expressions of our divine nature. It moves beyond “What can I get?” or “How can I feel better?” and asks, “How can I be a vessel for love in this world?”

This does not mean we should reject self-care or personal healing. On the contrary, these are essential. But when they become the *only* focus, spirituality can become another form of consumerism or self-obsession rather than a path of genuine awakening.

The Invitation to Go Deeper

Many people who have walked the New Age path eventually reach a point where they feel something is missing. They may have had powerful experiences, done extensive healing work, or achieved a certain level of self-awareness, but still feel a deeper calling. This is often the soul’s way of saying that it is time to move beyond spiritual concepts and into true embodiment.

Christ Consciousness asks more of us than most New Age paths. It asks us to:

- Face our shadows with honesty and courage
- Take full responsibility for our energy and choices
- Live in alignment with love even when it is difficult

- Remain humble while fully owning our divine nature

This path is not always comfortable. It does not always feel good in the moment. But it leads to something far more real and lasting than spiritual highs or temporary manifestations.

Chapter 8: The Inner Requirements (Sovereignty, Discernment, Frequency)

In the previous chapter, we explored how Christ Consciousness differs from much of what is taught in New Age and modern spiritual circles. We saw that while many paths focus on healing, manifestation, and raising vibration, true embodiment requires something deeper and more grounded.

Embodying Christ Consciousness is not something that happens simply because we want it to, or because we practice spiritual techniques. It requires specific inner conditions — qualities of being that must be cultivated

over time. Without these inner foundations, our attempts at embodiment often remain superficial or unstable.

There are three core inner requirements that form the foundation of this path:

- **Sovereignty**
- **Discernment**
- **Frequency**

Let us explore each of them.

Sovereignty

Sovereignty is the ability to govern yourself from within. It means taking full responsibility for your thoughts, emotions, energy, and choices. A sovereign being does not give their power away to external authorities, whether those are religious institutions, spiritual teachers, governments, or even their own fears and conditioning. Christ Consciousness cannot be embodied by someone who remains spiritually dependent or emotionally enslaved. When we are still seeking validation, approval, or salvation from outside of ourselves, we remain in a state of separation — the very state that Christ Consciousness dissolves.

Sovereignty does not mean isolation or selfishness. It means standing in your own truth and power while remaining open to love and guidance. It means no longer needing someone else to tell you who you are or what is true for you.

Without sovereignty, we will always be vulnerable to distortion — whether that distortion comes from religion, New Age teachings, or our own unresolved wounds.

Discernment

Discernment is the ability to clearly perceive the truth of a situation, person, teaching, or energy. It is not the same as judgment. Judgment comes from fear or ego. Discernment comes from clarity and inner alignment.

In a world filled with spiritual information, teachers, and experiences, discernment is essential. Not everything that sounds spiritual is aligned with truth. Not everything that feels good is truly good for us. And not everything that claims to be “light” is free from shadow.

True discernment requires us to be honest with ourselves. It asks us to look beyond surface appearances and feel into the deeper energy behind things. It also requires us to be willing to question even our own beliefs and spiritual experiences.

Without discernment, we can easily be led astray — by others or by our own ego. With discernment, we can navigate the spiritual path with clarity and integrity.

Frequency

Frequency refers to the vibrational state of our being. Everything we think, feel, believe, and do carries a frequency. Christ Consciousness is a very high and pure frequency — one of unconditional love, truth, and oneness. We cannot embody this frequency if we are consistently operating from fear, anger, resentment, unworthiness, or separation. This does not mean we must be perfect or never experience difficult emotions. It means we must be willing to do the inner work required to raise and stabilise our frequency over time.

Our frequency is influenced by many things:

- The thoughts we think

- The emotions we dwell in
- The food we eat
- The environments we spend time in
- The relationships we maintain
- The media and information we consume
- The spiritual practices we engage in

Embodying Christ Consciousness requires us to become conscious of these influences and make choices that support a higher, more loving frequency. This is not about spiritual perfectionism. It is about alignment.

When our frequency is high and stable, embodying Christ Consciousness becomes more natural. When our frequency is low or chaotic, embodiment becomes much more difficult.

These Three Work Together

Sovereignty, discernment, and frequency are not separate. They support and strengthen each other.

- Sovereignty gives us the inner strength to stand in our truth.
- Discernment helps us see clearly what is true and aligned.
- Frequency determines the vibrational reality we live in and attract.

Without sovereignty, we give our power away and lose our centre.

Without discernment, we can be misled by false light or our own illusions.

Without a high and stable frequency, we cannot sustain the embodiment of Christ Consciousness for long.

These inner requirements are not optional extras. They are the foundation upon which everything else is built.

The Path Requires Inner Strength

Many people are drawn to spirituality because they want to feel better, escape suffering, or experience beautiful states of consciousness. While these desires are understandable, true embodiment asks for something more. It asks us to become strong enough to hold a high frequency even when life is difficult. It asks us to become clear enough to see through illusion. It asks us to become sovereign enough to no longer need external validation or rescue.

This is why embodiment is rare. It is not because Christ Consciousness is only available to special people. It is because few are willing to do the deep, consistent inner work required to become a living vessel for this frequency.

In the next chapter, we will explore one of the most important parts of this inner work: **breaking the agreements** that keep us bound to old patterns of separation, limitation, and control. These agreements — many of them unconscious — are one of the biggest blocks to embodiment. Until they are recognised and released, we will continue to feel held back, no matter how much spiritual work we do.

The path of embodiment is not about becoming more spiritual.

It is about becoming more whole, more sovereign, and more aligned with the truth of who you are.

This is the real work.

And it begins within.

Chapter 9: Breaking the Agreements That Block Embodiment

In the previous chapter, we explored the three core inner requirements for embodying Christ Consciousness: Sovereignty, Discernment, and Frequency. These qualities form the foundation upon which true embodiment can be built. However, even when we understand these requirements and genuinely desire to embody this higher frequency, many of us still feel blocked or held back.

One of the biggest reasons for this is the presence of **unconscious agreements** that we carry — agreements that keep us tied to old patterns of limitation, separation, and control.

These agreements are often invisible to us, yet they exert a powerful influence over our lives. Until they are recognised and consciously released, they continue to act as invisible chains that prevent us from fully stepping into our divine nature.

What Are These Agreements?

Agreements are energetic, emotional, and sometimes spiritual contracts that we have made — often unconsciously — with people, systems, beliefs, or even aspects of ourselves. These agreements can form in many ways:

- Through childhood experiences and family conditioning
- Through religious or cultural programming
- Through trauma or moments of deep emotional pain

- Through ancestral patterns passed down through bloodlines
- Through soul-level agreements made before this lifetime
- Through interactions with other beings or energies (both seen and unseen)

Some of these agreements were made in an attempt to survive, to be loved, to belong, or to feel safe. Others were made under manipulation, deception, or pressure. Many were never consciously chosen at all — they were simply absorbed from the world around us.

Over time, these agreements become part of our energetic structure. They shape how we see ourselves, how we relate to others, and what we believe is possible for us. They can create repeating patterns of limitation, unworthiness, fear, or self-sabotage that no amount of positive thinking or spiritual practice seems to fully resolve.

How Agreements Block Embodiment

Christ Consciousness is a state of pure love, truth, and oneness. It cannot fully express through us when we are still bound by agreements that contradict these qualities. For example, if we carry an unconscious agreement that says:

- “I am not worthy of love unless I prove myself”
- “I must keep the peace, even if it costs me my truth”
- “I am separate from God and need to earn my way back”
- “It is not safe to fully shine my light”
- “I must carry the burdens of others to be a good person”

...then these agreements will continue to create resistance to embodiment, no matter how much we desire to awaken.

These agreements act like energetic programs running in the background of our consciousness. They filter our perception, influence our choices, and keep us operating from old frequencies of fear and separation — even when we consciously want to live from love.

Signs That Old Agreements Are Active

Many people are unaware that they are still carrying these agreements until they begin to look for them. Some common signs include:

- Repeating patterns in relationships or life circumstances that feel difficult to break
- A persistent sense of unworthiness or “not enoughness,” even after doing healing work
- Strong emotional reactions that seem out of proportion to the situation
- Feeling blocked or restricted in your spiritual growth, despite genuine effort
- A sense of being controlled, watched, or influenced by unseen forces
- Difficulty fully receiving love, abundance, or support
- A deep inner conflict between what you know to be true and how you actually live

These signs are not signs of failure. They are invitations to become aware of the agreements that are still running beneath the surface.

How to Break These Agreements

Breaking unconscious agreements is one of the most powerful steps we can take on the path of embodiment. This process requires honesty, courage, and a willingness to take responsibility for our own energy.

Here are some of the most effective ways to work with these agreements:

1. Awareness and Acknowledgment

The first step is to become aware that these agreements exist. Simply bringing them into conscious awareness begins to weaken their power. You can do this by reflecting on repeating patterns in your life and asking: “What belief or agreement might be underneath this?”

2. Conscious Revocation

Once you become aware of an agreement, you can consciously revoke it. This can be done through spoken or written declaration. A simple but powerful statement is: “I now revoke, rescind, and nullify any and all agreements — conscious or unconscious — that I have made with any person, system, belief, or energy that does not serve my highest good and my full embodiment of Christ Consciousness. I reclaim my sovereign power and align only with love and truth.”

You can repeat this as often as needed, especially when old patterns resurface.

3. Inner Child and Ancestral Work

Many agreements were formed in childhood or inherited through our bloodlines. Working with inner child healing and ancestral healing can help release these inherited contracts at a deeper level.

4. Frequency and Embodiment Practices

As you raise your frequency through conscious living, meditation, and alignment with love, many old agreements

naturally begin to dissolve. The higher your frequency becomes, the harder it is for lower vibrational agreements to remain active.

5. Daily Practice of Sovereignty

Every time you choose truth over fear, love over control, and your own inner authority over external pressure, you strengthen your sovereignty and weaken old agreements. This is not a one-time event — it is a daily practice.

The Role of Sovereignty

Breaking agreements is ultimately an act of sovereignty. It is a declaration that you are no longer willing to be bound by old contracts that no longer serve your highest evolution. It is a reclaiming of your power and your divine birthright.

When we break these agreements, we create space for Christ Consciousness to move more freely through us. We begin to feel lighter, clearer, and more aligned with our true nature. Old patterns lose their grip, and new possibilities open up.

This is not always an easy process. Some agreements are deeply rooted and may require time, patience, and repeated work to fully release. But every agreement that is broken is one less chain holding you back from fully embodying the Flame.

In the next chapter, we will explore another essential part of this inner work: **healing the wound of separation**. This wound — the deep belief that we are separate from Source and from each other — is one of the core distortions that Christ Consciousness came to heal. Until this wound is

addressed, many of our agreements and patterns will continue to regenerate.

The path of embodiment requires us to become willing to see what has been hidden and to release what no longer serves. This is not always comfortable, but it is deeply liberating.

You are not broken.

You are not bound forever.

Chapter 10: Healing the Wound of Separation

In the previous chapter, we explored the power of breaking unconscious agreements that keep us bound to old patterns of limitation and control. These agreements often stem from a deeper root — a wound that lives at the core of the human experience.

This wound is so fundamental that almost every spiritual teaching throughout history has tried to address it in some way. It is the wound that Christ Consciousness came to heal.

It is the **wound of separation**.

What Is the Wound of Separation?

The wound of separation is the deep, often unconscious belief that we are fundamentally separate from Source,

from each other, and from our own divine nature. It is the feeling — sometimes quiet, sometimes overwhelming — that we are alone, unworthy, or disconnected from the love and wholeness that is our true essence.

This wound did not begin with any single event or lifetime. It is ancient. How the Wound Was Created and Reinforced

How the Wound Blocks Embodiment

As long as we carry the wound of separation, we will unconsciously:

- Sabotage our own joy and success
- Struggle to receive love and support
- Feel unworthy of the very things we most desire

Your collective role may include:

- Being a steady, loving presence in your family, community, or workplace
- Sharing your truth when it feels aligned (without needing to convince anyone)
- Creating or supporting projects, art, or work that carries this frequency

- Holding space for others who are awakening
- Simply living your life in a way that demonstrates what is possible

You do not need to have a big platform or a formal spiritual role to serve the collective. Some of the most powerful ways this frequency spreads is through quiet, consistent presence. A single person living in alignment with love and truth can influence far more than they realise.

You Are Not Responsible for Saving Others

One of the most important things to understand is that your role is **not** to save or fix anyone else. Every soul is on their own journey and has their own timing. Trying to force awakening or healing onto others is not aligned with Christ Consciousness. It often comes from the ego's need to feel important or in control.

True service respects free will. It offers what you have been given, but it does not demand that others receive it. It trusts that each person is exactly where they need to be on their path.

This does not mean you cannot speak your truth or offer support. It simply means you do so without attachment to the outcome. You offer from love, not from the need to be needed.

The Power of One Aligned Being

It is easy to feel small in the face of the world's challenges. It is easy to wonder if one person's embodiment can really make a difference. But the truth is that one person living in alignment with Christ Consciousness has a powerful effect on the collective field.

Every time you choose love over fear...

Every time you choose truth over illusion...

...you are strengthening the ascending timeline. You are anchoring this frequency on Earth. You are helping to make it easier for others to remember.

You are not just healing yourself. You are participating in the healing of the collective. Your personal awakening contributes to the whole.

Avoiding Overwhelm and Spiritual Ego

This does not make you better than anyone else — it simply means you have a particular role to play in this chapter of humanity's story.
